With more than 70 areas of study in the life and clinical sciences, business, humanities, government and politics, and education, our strong academic programs encourage students to expand their worldview, engage in critical thinking and excel across all dimensions while obtaining hard and soft skill sets employers are looking for.

CURRICULUM RECOMMENDATIONS

We look for applicants who have a strong academic preparation. We recommend that students have completed the following courses in high school:

- English: 4 years
- Foreign Language: 2 years of the same language
- Mathematics: 3 years, including Algebra II*
- Social Studies: 3 years
- Laboratory Sciences: 3 years

*We recommend four years of mathematics and science for a student considering college study in Business, Chemistry, Mathematics and Nursing.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

A completed application for admission should include:

- Common Application and essay
- Official secondary school transcript or GED scores
- Two letters of recommendation (from an academic teacher and a school counselor)
- Interview (Recommended, but not required)
- SAT or ACT scores (optional)
