CURRICULUM RECOMMENDATIONS

We look for applicants who have a strong academic preparation. We recommend that students have completed the following courses in high school:

- · English: 4 years
- Foreign Language: 2 years of the same language
- Mathematics: 3 years, including Algebra II*
- · Social Studies: 3 years
- Laboratory Sciences: 3 years
- *We recommend four years of mathematics and science for a student considering college study in Business, Chemistry, Mathematics and Nursing.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

A completed application for admission should include:

- Common Application and essay
- Official secondary school transcript or GED scores
- Two letters of recommendation (from an academic teacher and a school counselor)
- Interview (Recommended, but not required)
